

SOTERO CURRENCY (SOTC) — WALLET SETUP & INSTRUCTION GUIDE

Trust-backed digital currency deployed on the Polygon (MATIC) Blockchain

✓ STEP 1: CONNECT TO THE POLYGON NETWORK

Your wallet must be configured to support the **Polygon (MATIC)** blockchain.

If you haven't added it yet, follow these manual settings:

Polygon Mainnet RPC Settings:

- **Network Name:** Polygon Mainnet
 - **RPC URL:** <https://rpc-mainnet.maticvigil.com>
 - **Chain ID:** 137
 - **Currency Symbol:** MATIC
 - **Block Explorer URL:** <https://polygonscan.com>

✓ STEP 2: ADD SOTC TOKEN TO YOUR WALLET

SOTC is compatible with any **ERC-20 wallet** that allows **custom token imports** and **Polygon RPC support**, including:

- **MetaMask** (recommended)
- **Brave Wallet**
- **Ledger** (via MetaMask or MyEtherWallet)

♦ **Mobile Wallets**

- **Trust Wallet**
 - **Coinbase Wallet**
 - **MathWallet**
 - **TokenPocket**
 - **SafePal**
 - Any **WalletConnect**-enabled app

INSTRUCTIONS FOR SPECIFIC WALLETS

♦ **MetaMask**

1. Open MetaMask → Click “Networks” → Add Network
 2. Enter the **Polygon Mainnet RPC** info above
 3. Switch to Polygon
 4. Click “Import Token” → Paste contract: 0x999D . . . Dd69
 5. Token will appear in your wallet
-

♦ **Trust Wallet**

1. Tap the top-right icon to search tokens
 2. Scroll to the bottom → “Add Custom Token”
 3. Switch Network to **Polygon**
 4. Paste SOTC contract address
 5. Token symbol and decimals will auto-fill
-

♦ **Coinbase Wallet**

1. Open the app → Tap browser icon
2. Visit: <https://quickswap.exchange>
3. Connect your wallet

4. Paste contract into token field if SOTC doesn't appear
 5. Add it manually in Assets tab if needed

♦ **WalletConnect**

1. Visit <https://quickswap.exchange> from your desktop
 2. Click **Connect Wallet** → Choose **WalletConnect**
 3. Scan the QR code with your wallet app
 4. Swap or view your SOTC balance after connecting

HOW TO TRADE SOTC ON QUICKSWAP

1. Go to: <https://quickswap.exchange>
 2. Click “Swap”
 3. In the token selector, paste the SOTC contract address
 4. Select token to swap *from* (MATIC, USDC, etc.)
 5. Confirm slippage and fees
 6. Approve and swap
-

SECURITY REMINDERS

- Always **verify the contract address** before swapping:
0xc01e8cfd86ce0d4757ee008c885bb7e0655a839a

- Never send SOTC to a non-Polygon wallet (e.g., Ethereum Mainnet)
 - Avoid third-party apps that promise “airdrops” or “token doubling”
